SUCCESS STORY

When one door closes - another one opens. In the case of the 1920s-era Fire Station 16 in downtown Salisbury, that door opened when the operators of the 12,000 square foot fire station that was turned into a mixed-use entertainment venue, locally known as Headquarters Live.

"After several years of operation we realized the true potential of this historically significant building was not being maximized," said Brad Gillis, Principal with Gillis Gilkerson.

As the curtain was closing on Headquarters Live, The Daily Times was looking to relocate from a 40,000 square foot space in Northwood Industrial Park on the north side of town. The company no longer printed its papers from its Salisbury warehouse location and was looking for more office space with the intent of relocating closer to the community's core. After looking at several downtown locations, the answer was found in the heart of Salisbury's iconic brick fire station.
