

## FREEMAN ARTS PAVILION BOX OFFICE & MAIN ENTRANCE

With the pressure of ensuring the project's completion for the venue's first concert of the season, every detail mattered. The result was a breathtaking entrance that seamlessly blends functionality with aesthetics.
