

MARYLAND FOOD BANK Salisbury, Maryland

In order to continue serving the needs of the Delmarva Peninsula, the Eastern Shore Branch of the Maryland Food Bank approached Gillis Gilkerson to discuss expansion options. Shortly thereafter, Gillis Gilkerson's construction team was hired to revitalize the Food Bank's office space and supplement the facility's coldstorage sorting room. These structural modifications and additions allowed the Food Bank to enhance and expand their volunteer program and distribution efforts.

The +/- 16,316 square foot project was divided into three phases, the first of which included the ground up construction of a new cold-storage facility with insulated panels and refrigeration; the new building is situated directly behind the original Food Bank facility. The scope of work for Phase II included interior renovations and reconfigurations aimed to enhance the office space with new flooring, ceilings and walls. Phase III then updated the warehouse, adding new doors and making other miscellaneous repairs
