

RICHARD A. HENSON CANCER INSTITUTE

OCEAN PINES | BERLIN, MARYLAND

In August 2017, Peninsula Regional Medical Center (PRMC) cut the ribbon on its new Richard A. Henson Cancer Institute in Ocean Pines (Berlin), Maryland. The 20,000 square foot state-of-the-art medical facility was constructed by Gillis Gilkerson and is located just outside of the Ocean Pines North Gate community off of Route 589 (Racetrack Road).

The Richard A. Henson Cancer Institute is home to a number of comprehensive cancer treatment service teams, including physician specialists with access to advanced treatment technology. Care provided in the facility extends to include TrueBeam radiation therapy—an image-guided radiotherapy and radiosurgery system that can achieve accuracy within less than a millimeter, helping to spare healthy tissue while killing cancer cells.

The Cancer Institute is also home to a modern, comfortable infusion therapy center, designed to ease the process of chemotherapy for patients. While being treated at the Richard A. Henson Cancer Institute, patients will also have access to cancer-patient support services, nutritional consultants, and a healing garden. PRMC also presents clinical trial opportunities as a result of their participation in the Johns Hopkins Clinical Research Network and National Cancer Institute studies.
