The center spans over 25,000 feet and is home of the JA offices in addition to their state of the art, highly immersive, experiential learning facility. The center will serve middle school and high school students from six counties on the Eastern Shore of Maryland and Accomack County, Virginia, with over 10,000 students expected to visit the center each year.
