Construction phases coincided with fundraising efforts, allowing the church to implement the expansive renovation in planned stages. Structural steel was implemented in phase one, followed by the construction of the 2,500 seat sanctuary auditorium complete with baptismal font, childcare classrooms, offices and all associated site work. Construction began in 1998, with the final phase completed in 2002.
