

CAMBRIA HOTEL REHOBOTH BEACH

Gillis Gilkerson completed construction of Cambria Hotel Rehoboth Beach, a +/- 100,00 square foot, 106 room flag hotel that features high-end amenities, and luxury finishes, just off of Route One in Rehoboth Beach, Delaware. The hotel amenities include indoor heated pool and hot tub, and outdoor pool with poolside bar, an in-house modern Mediterranean restaurant, the Veranda Restaurant and Bar, flexible meeting spaces, a grab-and-go market, gift shop, fitness center and arcade room. Three separate meeting rooms offer flexible conference and event space with its largest space able to accommodate over 500 banquets guests.

Guest rooms include Bluetooth mirrors, high-end finishes, ergonomic workspaces and 50 inch flat-screen TVs. The Cambria Hotel Rehoboth Beach also offers heightened accessibility, with an accessible swimming pool, and registration desk, eight wheelchair accessible rooms, and nineteen hearing accessible rooms for the deaf and hearing impaired. The exterior of the building features bright colors and lavish greenery, while the interior aesthetic features a more monochromatic look, utilizing a black and white color palette to enhance the elegance of the venue.

The job was lead by Project Manager Greg Ennis along with Superintendents Bill Schiavo, Bruce West, and Chris Powell. The hotel project broke ground in June 2022, and was completed in June 2024.
