

HEBRON SAVINGS BANK

BERLIN, MARYLAND

Gillis Gilkerson was honored to complete construction of Hebron Savings Bank branch in Berlin, Maryland. The +/- 3,000 sf branch is prominently located on the corner of Main Street at Route 50 Eastbound, positioned at an angle as if to greet passersby. The bank's friendly facade is reinforced with bright white cedar shake siding, accented with decorative molding, brick veneer and a bright blue standing seam metal roof that mirrors the brand's colors.

Hebron Savings Bank's branding and logo, complete with a shining sun, is reinforced in the design both inside and out, with features that prioritize natural light, visibility and accessible layouts. The first floor banking area creates a bright and sunny feel with an open floor plan, and floor-to-ceiling glass walls surrounding the customer service offices, each anchored with bold blue accent walls. Dormer windows and a roof cupola add welcoming character to the exterior, and even more natural light to the second floor offices and staff lounge. Two covered drive-thru lanes, and a dedicated ATM lane offer heightened customer convenience.

The project was overseen by Gillis Gilkerson Superintendent Jamie Heath and Project Manager / V.P. of Operations Matt Esham, and was completed in October of 2025.
